CBIL Classroom

The Computer Based Instruction Laboratory (CBIL) classroom, located in the Medical Sciences Building, contains 16 Dell PCs and a LaserJet printer. An overhead projection system is also provided for group instruction. The machines are maintained daily by CBIL staff.

Special software for user training sessions may be loaded with advance notice. All special software should be received five days prior to a scheduled training session to allow for proper installation and testing of the software on the computers.
